SETUP AND PRINTING GUIDE



Premium Edition 2 to 120 People:

Things to print, email, watch or read before the night:

- This printing guide
- How to run a murder mystery video <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Oog0FQK1oec>
- Your invitations - Print or email these to your guests

Things to send to your presenter before the night:

- Presenter's Handbook - Print and staple, email to your host if required
- The Full Story - Print and staple, email to your host if required
- Prop 1, Prop 2
- Any special materials for the opening of the game

Things to purchase before the night:

- Safety Pins - **Up to 120** (1 per guest for name badges)
- 18 pens
- **Any materials required for Prop 2**
- 1 pair of handcuffs

You need to print and guillotine these materials before your party!

Things to have ready on the night:

Up to 120 guests:

- Central Character Name badges - **Print all** in colour on light card if possible (guillotine)
- Remaining Name badges 16 to 60 - **Print up to 45** (1 per guest excluding central characters) in colour on light card if possible (guillotine)
- Remaining Name badges 61 to 120 - **Print up to 45** (1 per guest excluding central characters) in colour on light card if possible (guillotine)
- Safety Pins - **Up to 120** (1 per guest for name badges)
- Round 1, 2 and 3 clues - **Print 2 copies** in colour on white paper (guillotine) if you don't have a colour printer try and print each round on a different colour paper
- Prop 1 - **Print 1 copy** in colour on white paper
- Prop 2 - **Print 1 copy** in colour on white paper (some Prop 2s need more copies)
- Prop 3 - **Print up to 18 copies** (1 per team e.g. 1 per 5 to 8 people) printed in colour on white paper
- Certificates - **Print up to 40 copies** (1 per 3 people) in colour on white paper (guillotine)
- Sleuthing Notes - **Print up to 18 copies** (1 per team) printed in b/w on white paper and stapled
- 18 pens and 1 pair of handcuffs
- Welcome signs/posters - 1 or more copies printed in colour A3

Optional:

- Small prizes e.g. chocolates or wooden spoons
- Copies of the printable quiz
