



TEAM DIRECTIONS

Read this out loud to your team!

You have discovered that there has been a tragic murder! If you are our departed friend, you are vital to this mystery. You should help your team find your killer.

Your team's goal is to identify the killer and how the murder happened. Our murderer is someone here and may even be someone in your group! However, our murderer has amnesia and **doesn't remember committing the crime**. It could be anyone, even you!

Soon, you will be given paper clues that come together to help you know what happened. You should pass these clues around to everyone in your team. You can trust your team, but do not trust the other groups. Look around and make sure you know who is in your team. You don't want impostors sneaking information.

On this sheet, you can write down the information you collect. However, if you only use the clues you receive from your presenter you will not solve the murder. You need to swap clues, that means, hand over a paper clue and get one back from other groups. You can also eavesdrop or use your other charms to gather information. The only rule is **you must not steal clues from other teams**.

There are three rounds of clues. After each round, you need to pick a spokesperson. This role is easy and fun. The spokesperson uses the clues to **accuse** other characters of evil deeds e.g., "I think the murderer is..." or "I know who found the weapon, it was...". The spokesperson may even **lie or mislead!** There are no wrong answers!

At the end of round three, we will share our final theories. This is where each team explains the events leading up to the murder, and finally, they identify who committed the crime. At this point, if you think the murderer is in your team, do not protect them as this will prevent your team from winning.

Key points:

- Swap lots of clues
- Don't steal clues
- Spokespeople can do no wrong, go for it!
- After round 3, tell us who the killer is and how it happened

**The team that correctly identifies the murderer
and whose final story is the most accurate
will be deemed the winners.**
